Temple Judea financial assistance is a *needs based* program, and families must demonstrate true financial need in order to qualify.

Assistance is granted on a case by case basis and limited by the money we have available for this purpose. Unfortunately, we cannot grant assistance to all who apply for it, as the funds for assistance are limited.

A small committee reviews all the applications. The committee consists of the Vice President of Membership Commitments, the board trustee with responsibility for this area, the Executive Director, members of the Finance Department, and any others who are called in to assist. All information is kept strictly confidential by all parties.

INSTRUCTIONS

Please fill out the entire application. You must fill in *all* the blanks. Any blank may render your application incomplete and may delay processing of your application. You are also free to attach additional information if you'd like.

Processing the applications takes time. You may receive a phone call or email from a member of the committee, asking for additional information or clarification while your application is processed. You can expect to wait four to six weeks for a final decision.

When complete, submit your application in a sealed envelope addressed to the Finance Department.

RELIGIOUS SCHOOL and NURSERY SCHOOL FAMILIES: Your application for school is not complete until you submit this application. We cannot hold spots in class without this complete form.
